

ADOPTING THE IMPLEMENTING R.A. 9994 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS EXPANDED SENIOR CITIZENS ACT EFFECTIVE JULY 2010 (BR No. 026, S-2010)

SECTION 1. RA No. 9994, Article 12, Sec. 1 – grants a minimum of five percent (5%) relative to monthly water consumption provided that it does not exceed thirty cubic meters (30 cu.m.). This privilege is granted per household regardless of the number of senior citizens residing therein.

SECTION 2. Article 12, Sec.2 (Fifty Percent Discount) grants a 50% discount on all water..... Consumption for DSWD –accredited senior citizen centers and residential care institutions or group homes that are government–run or organized and operated by non–stock, non profit domestic corporations, primarily for the purpose of promoting the well–being of abandoned, neglected, unattached or homeless senior citizens. Such senior citizen centers and residential care group homes must be in operation for at least six (6) months and must have a separate meter for said utilities/services.

Documentary Requirements:

1. *Fill-up application form*
2. *2" x 2" Picture ID*
3. *Proof of residence/Barangay Clearance*
4. *Valid Senior Citizen Card ID No.*
5. *Other IDs presented*
6. *Authorization letter (If applying through representative)*
7. *Government issued ID (of the representative)*

Condition for the availment;

1. *The Senior Citizen must be a resident of the household.*
2. *Consumption should not exceed 30 cubic meters.*
3. *This is granted by household regardless of the number of Senior Citizens therein.*
4. *Meter registration should be in the name of the senior Citizen for a period of one year.*
